

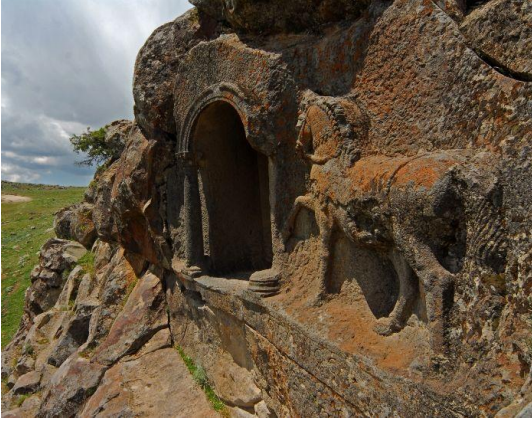
Dear National Federation,

Turkish Equestrian Federation is proud to host a spectacular national endurance competition at the historical site Beyşehir in the city of Konya, Turkey:

### **‘Lukyanus Endurance Challenge Cup 2017’**

The competition will be held on the dates of 9 – 10 September 2017 and is open to all riders from all over the world on borrowed horses. The ‘Lukyanus Endurance Challenge Cup 2017’ will be held for the first time in Turkey and will be a great scenic ride in the middle of beautiful Anatolia.

*‘Lukyanus Monument – Pargetting horse - was built on a rock as a relief of a horse. A 2,000-year-old tablet that reveals racing rules was uncovered in the Beyşehir district of the Central Anatolian province of Konya (Turkey). Being part of the Lukyanus Monument, the tablet was apparently built to honour a jockey named Lukyanus, who died at an early age in the Pisidian era. The discovery was made on the site of an ancient hippodrome.’*
