



**GENERALI WORLD CLUB TOURNAMENT
GENERALI OPEN 2017
JUMPING
Lamotte Beuvron 26-27-28 July 2017**

The Generali World Club Tournament is a friendly international competition which involves riding schools from the whole world. This event is part of the French National Riding School Championships (Generali Open de France) which involves 11 different events and brings together more than 10 000 riders in a sporty and friendly atmosphere. As well as the simple pleasure of sport, this show offers an excellent opportunity for meeting and exchange.

1 – RULES

The Generali World Club Tournament takes place in accordance with the FFE Competition Regulations, 2017 edition, completed by the rules published on www.ffe.com

Discipline: Jumping

2 – PARTICIPATION

Each team must be accompanied by a **Team Leader / Chef d'Equipe** responsible for ensuring the team arrives equipped with **2 of their country's national flags**.

Riders

The World Club Tournament is a team event. **One team per country.**

- French and foreign clubs affiliated to the FFE: teams of 3 to 4 riders holding an FFE Club licence for the year 2017.
- French and foreign clubs not affiliated to the FFE: teams of 3 to 4 riders never having participated in any official international competitions. **Form B2 must be completed for every rider not in possession of an FFE licence.**

Horses & Ponies

All horses and ponies of 5 years and over must be in possession of both identification documents and papers proving they are up to date with all vaccinations in compliance with the EU legislation in force. Foreign and overseas riders may take part using their own horses or horses hired in advance and provided on arrival. (See Entry Form A).

Entries: Entries and stabling are offered by the FFE !

Stabling: 4 stables will automatically be reserved when we will receive your entries.

5 – PROGRAMME

Technical norms

(Regulation reference: 1st CSO series index category E)

Speed	350 mpm
Number of obstacles	10/12
Oxers	Front: 90cm max Behind: 95cm max
Max. width of oxers	100cm
Max. width of fences	100cm
Combinations	1 or 2 doubles

Order of events

The competition takes place in 2 stages over two days. Each rider participating in the entire competition with the same horse. All team members must participate in each of the two stages. Before the 2 stages, there will be Warm Up 26 July, to see the team level and adapt tests.

1st round

Table A: against the clock

Starting order: according to program

The team's result is obtained by adding its three best couple's penalty points.

The accumulated time of three better results of the team decides between the equally ranked.

2nd round

1st stage

Table A: not against the clock

Starting order: reverse order of the ranking after the first round.

The team's result is obtained by adding the penalty points of the three best couples during this round.

In each round a team is eliminated if at least two couples are eliminated from a team of 4 and one couple from a team of 3.

Couples eliminated in the first round may take part in the second round.

Teams eliminated in the first round may take part in the second round.

Teams eliminated in the first and/or second round will be allocated the score of the last team of the round in question, plus 30 points with double the maximum time allocated multiplied by three.

Teams not participating in the first round may not participate in the second round.

2nd stage

Table A: against the clock

Starting order: reverse order of the standings after the first step and the first round of the second stage. In case of equality, the time of the first round the equally ranked.

Final Ranking

The ranking is calculated by adding the penalty points of the 1st round and 2 stage of the second round.

In case of equal points the total of three rounds, the cumulative time of 3 best riders of the team of the 2nd step of the second stage will define the order of the podium and ranking.
